

Dear Donors :

We are happy to report that with the funds we have on hand we will be able to build three (3) classrooms with toilets for the children of Cogon, Guiuan. Delivery date is set on the first week of July 2014.

On 10 April 2014, I signed the Memorandum of Understanding with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Guiuan and Department (Ministry) of Education (DEPED) to build 2 classrooms with toilets based on the quotes we received from prospective builders. After diligent search we found Steel Core Homes Inc. (SCH) a manufacturer, supplier and builder of structurally sound steel structures with elegant architectural finish private homes and commercial buildings. SCH have built homes for the earthquake victims in Haiti. SCH classroom buildings has 200-230 kph wind resistance, Intensity 7 quake resistance, insulated walls and can be built in one (1) month. SCH design is approved by the Philippine government

I signed the contract with SCH on 08 May 2014.

To date the, school administration and the residents of the community are working together clearing the site. On 28 May, SCH will begin laying the slab. Barring any unforeseen event the 3 - classroom building will be ready for turn- over on or before the first week of July 2014.

As I write, we continue to receive cash donations and pledges for school chairs and other school materials for the children of Cogon. AGILE will be holding a fund raising event in mid-June. Fingers crossed we may be able to build three (3) more classrooms before the end of 2014.
